

Environmental Policy



Lotus Commercial (the Company) aims to reduce our impact on the environment by ensuring that environmentally responsible practices are embraced within our organisation. We specifically undertake to:

- Ensure the environment is considered in all aspects of our business planning and operations, consistent with sound business management practices.
- Meet, and where possible exceed the requirements of all relevant environmental legislation, regulations, and licences including the requirements of AS/NZS ISO 14001 standard.
